(Optional)	Tips & Suggestions for Teachers
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ensure students comfortable practicing words with multiple tashdids - Advanced topic (applies to recitation, not simple reading): prolonging sound on نَ، مَ - easy to learn this rule - practice blank letters and blank bends
(Optional)	Ideas that may be offered to mothers to make it easier/fun to teach kids
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This rule about prolonging sound on noon and meem with tashdeed is for recitation (qiraat) and not used in simple Arabic reading, so for younger children, can leave this till they know the difference between reading and recitation. But this rule is easy to learn. - If teaching kids, can say something like, there are two special letters that make a nice humming sound with tashdeed.
